Appearance Scottish larch ranges in colour from pinky-brown in the heartwood

Knots Each board is hand Graded to BS1186-3 Part 4 Class 2; boards contain tight live knots with a maximum diameter of 50mm

Weathering The boards are left naturally to weather , the colour will change to a silver grey. We can factory apply SIOO:X to give the timber a consistent accelerated weathered appearance.

Durability Class 3. Larch has a lifespan of 30 years. Larch is a naturally durable timber and, for external cladding purposes, is classed as “moderately durable”

Movement High, Can be more prone to bowing and cupping compared to species we sell

Profiles Shadowgap, Secretfix Shadowgap, PAR, Tongue & Groove, Rainscreen, Decking

Factory Finishes Fine Sawn, Unfinished, Brushed, Light colour Char and brush smooth, SIOO:X

Fire protection Can be coated in-house to achieve Euroclass BS1 - D0
